1. The purpose of this survey is to gather **all concerns** on the current constitution of NRNA CC Australia and **suggestions to address** those concerns.
2. All 30 Articles of the constitution are available for revision/amendment. Please use the following format (attached) to provide your comments and suggestions.
3. If you are concerned with how the NRNA leadership is currently being elected and have an alternative model the details of which you wish to present for discussion, please feel free to include it as an appendix.
4. It is envisaged that after the due date for comments/suggestions the state coordinators will organise a workshop in each state to discuss and incorporate the suggestions and prepare a new draft constitution (state version).
5. All eight drafts will be reviewed and combined into a single draft (national version) by the task force and then sent back to the states for further discussion.
6. State coordinators will organise the second workshop to discuss and receive feedbacks on the national version.
7. The constitution amendment taskforce will then prepare a final version of the draft by taking these feedbacks into considerations and submit it to the NCC. The NCC will present the draft as presented by the taskforce to the special general meeting for discussion and endorsement.

National Draft (task force):	January 20, 2012
Second state workshop (national draft):	February 20, 2012
Final Draft Submission:	March 31, 2012.
